Spring Cleanup

Bulk Trash Removal Guidelines

This year a large dumpster will be available in the lot in front of Building 33 from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm for bulk removal, this is on a first come, *first serve basis until full*. *You are responsible to transport items from your unit to the dumpster.* We may have a dolly to assist in bringing items to the dumpster. **We will need volunteers to help at the dumpster and the cleanup.**

Please plan to attend. Please bring a check with you to the dumpster with your items. No cash!

The cost of items are as follows:

- Couch \$60
- Sleeper Sofa \$75
- Mattress and Box Spring \$90
- Recliner \$50
- Chairs \$10
- End Tables \$20
- Coffee Tables \$40
- Lamps \$5

The following items are not allowed to be placed in the dumpster!

Hazardous materials are prohibited for disposal through your rented dumpster.

Here are some general examples of items that are **NOT allowed**:

- Aerosol cans
- All liquids
- Antifreeze
- Appliances
- Asbestos
- Barrels
- Batteries
- Chemical products
- Computers
- Contaminated oils (mixed with solvents, gasoline, etc.)
- Dirt
- Fluorescent tubes
- Hazardous waste
- Herbicides and pesticides
- Lubricating/hydraulic oil
- Medical waste
- Microwaves
- Monitors
- Motor oil
- Oil filters
- Other flammable liquids
- Paint (except completely dried latex paint cans, no liquids)
- Petroleum-contaminated soil/lead paint chips
- Propane tanks
- Radioactive material
- Railroad ties
- Solvents
- Televisions
- Tires
- Transmission oil
- Yard Waste

Electronics will not be accepted!!!! You can recycle your electronics as follows: All electronics will be recycled at Kidder Twp. recycling day on Saturday, April 16, 2022, between 9 am and 11 pm or until truck is filled. Please plan on bringing all electronics there. Last year it filled! The Kidder Twp. flyer is attached.
